



## Green my School Hangout

### Phase I nearly concluded!

After a few months of work we can see now some results. Measuring our waste, emissions, unsustainable food consumption and green areas has been the starting point. Now we know all the bad things that we do to our environment, we have

even quantified the damage. It's time to change things!

Our four schools have been working on the same issues during the year, now we should reflect and share our thoughts.

Please, follow this protocol to talk to your counterparts in other countries. Remember that **you will need to write a report at the end of the conversation**, so take notes during the videoconference.

### 1 Let's start!

You might already know your peers in other countries from previous conversations but, even so, you should introduce yourselves. Each one of you should tell his/her name to the other members of the team. You might want to share details about your upcoming holidays (when you get, where you are going, etc). Making a few informal questions of this type will break the ice.

### 2 Let's share our findings

All the members of the videoconference should have been working on the same topic. You should explain your school's findings to the other school's students. Decide before hand who will be talking and prepare a small report. Explain the results of your work to the others. For example, if you have been working on emissions, tell the others the kilograms of CO<sub>2</sub> that your school produces and what percentage of it comes from heating, lighting, etc... A brief description of your results should be enough.

**Remember to write down what the other school tells you because you should include their results in your report.**

### 3 Did you enjoy working on the project?

Let's find out what you think. Please ask the others:

- What did you like about the project?
- What did you dislike about it?
- What do you think about the Green My School project? What do you expect from the project next school year?
- What do you think that we should introduce in the project next school year?
- Do you think that you will be able to make your school more sustainable?
- Will you be traveling to Spain next October? Are you excited about it if so?

**You should also include the answers in your report.**
