Implementation

1. Teach other students about sorting: a competition between classes and with a prize.
2. Drinking fountains: convince headmaster by collecting plastic bottles and let him see them. Email the minister.
3. Use recycle paper: a box where students can throw paper that only was used on one side
4. Improve our way of recycle: place the bins in different places in each classroom, in different colors to learn how to sort
5. Use tablets instead of paper: rent the tablets during the year and you can buy it at the end of the year or just give it back to school.

6. Compost heap: collect it in a special bin and then you can bring it to someone who can use it for animals or growing plants.
7. Separate bins for chemical waste: collect the waste in a separate bin and bring it to a special fabric that can destroy it.
8. Lunch boxes: otherwise punished by cleaning playground during breaktime
